NOMINATION AND APPLICATION DEADLINES

1st term & annual students

NOMINATION 18th of May

APPLICATION 1st of June

2nd term students

NOMINATION 16th of October

NOMINATION PROCESS

Partner institutions must submit student nominations via this [online form](#). After processing, application instructions are sent directly to nominated students, with partners copied.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Nominated students must complete an online application form and email the signed form along with their language certificate and transcript of records.



ACADEMIC INFORMATION

Exchange students have access to the full bachelor-level course offer of the Faculty. As course places are limited, flexibility is still recommended, and enrolment in specific courses cannot be guaranteed. Students are strongly advised to complete all compulsory modules required for graduation at their home institution.
