We are looking for an internationally outstanding personality who represents this area in research, teaching, and innovation.

In teaching, you will strengthen the offering of the KIT-Department of Economics and Management in the field of information systems. Participation in teaching is expected in the Bachelor and Master programs of Information Systems, Industrial Engineering and Management, Digital Economics, and Business Mathematics, including mandatory courses in the Bachelor programs. The willingness for interdisciplinary cooperation, the participation in academic self-administration, the proven ability to actively acquire third-party research funding are required. The commitment to the transfer of research results in business, society, and start-up activities are desired. The involvement in the collegial management of the Institute of Information Systems and Marketing (IISM) is expected.

Candidates should have exceptional scientific qualification, as demonstrated by a Habilitation degree, or an equivalent record in research and teaching. Employment conditions as outlined in § 14 (2) KITG (KIT-Act) in conjunction with § 47 LHG (Act of Baden-Württemberg on Universities and Colleges) shall apply.

KIT wishes to increase the proportion of female professors and therefore welcomes applications by female researchers. Recognized severely disabled persons will be preferred if they are equally qualified.
